为了充分体现便于自学的特点,《学学·练练·考考》有以下几个突出的特点: 1. 阅读文章的生词都旁注在课文的右侧,十分便于学生独立阅读; 2. 每课都加编了相应的Data Bank,为主教材中的相关表达练习提供辅助资料,这对提高学生的独立运用能力十分有益; 3. 在一般写作部分,各册加编了相关语法和写作知识的归纳小结,不仅为学生提供了其训练中所需要的语言材料,而且帮助学生系统地归纳整理所学语言知识,从而能更有效地在实践中使用; 4. 每册加编了2套模拟考题,第一册模拟英语应用能力B级考试;第二册的第一套模拟B级考试,第二套模拟A级考试;第3册模拟A级考试;第4册模拟大学本科英语4级考试。

这既便于学生自我检测,又便于衡量自己达到《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求(试行)》的程度。

综上所述,《学学·练练·考考》是学好《新编实用英语——综合教程》的重要辅学必备材料,它可以帮助学生复习所学内容,扩大练习园地,开拓知识视野,提高学习兴趣。
