Few conference abstracts , when they are submitted to a scholarly society , describe a completed paper or presentation. Indeed , many academics will pitch their papers first , then use the conference as a deadline to motivate the work. It's understood that conference abstracts may differ from the eventual presentation , which itself may be different from a paper published later. Academics need not worry that the talk they give at a conference must be exactly what was promised in the abstract. But the talk should not end up being on a completely different subject than what the conference abstract had promised. To avoid this problem , a successful conference abstract should reflect research that has already been underway , besides being well written. ....
