Instead of focusing on Physical descriptions of real lions. they created stone lions with their imagination. based on the general principles that they had learned. As a result, the stone lions took on imaginative new looks Few physical features of actual lions were preserved in these intricate artworks. Complex stone lions have the combined features of lions and other animals. One category includes mainly lions with the faces of horses or monkeys, or with the bodies of tigers or goats. In another group the stone lions have human physical characteristics and facial expressions; these are known as ioyful lions, angry li-ons, sad lions, smiling lions, baby - faced lions and octogenarian - faced lions. Baby stones are another telling example With exaggerated heads and downsized bod- ies and limbs, these stone lions look more like innocent children than ferocious predators. ...
