

<<血统、文化身份与美国化>>

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内容概要

《血统、文化身份与美国化:美国华裔小说主题研究》共分三章，另有一个绪论和结语，借用索罗斯（Werner Sollors）曾经提出的“血统世系”（descent）与“文化认同”（consent）这两个概念，对所选定的12部华裔美国英文小说（包括传记）中的族裔经验与文化认同进行系统考察，旨在揭示其对作品人物的美国化过程的促进或抑制作用，探讨文学人物乃至作家本人的“美国化”运行轨迹。

版权页： When taken as a postcolonial and postmodern text , Homebase is meant to restore "the beautiful and glorious past," and the heroic dimensions of the experiences of Chinese American pioneers together with the persecution , oppression and discrimination they suffer along the way. This has been achieved by narrating a number of personal journeys on airplanes , on trains , in cars or on foot , linking the four generations of sons and forefathers , whose varied contributions to Californian history remain unmarked in official history books. Most prominently , this tale includes collective grievances , which are shown in the continent-spanning labor of the protagonist's almost forgotten forefathers. Suddenly left alone in this world , Rainsford has to keep on driving to maintain his sanity : "When I started driving , I used to drive around at night through the hills , through empty streets , just drive around at night to keep from thinking about the pursuit of my own life" (H 10). Here , driving on an open road , traditionally linked to American—style freedom , has for him become a way of escaping from his pain of loss. Besides , it is pregnant with cultural connotations , revealed in this sentence : "I move across America picking up ghosts" (H 33). Here , the ghosts refer to those whose bodies were lying here and there , unclaimed and unattended to by white Americans. Since they have literally merged with the American land , Chan feels a communion with the land itself. In other words , he has come to claim America by claiming his ancestors as real and deserving Americans who should not be easily forgotten as such.
