In accordance with this Wfldffe Protection Law, on December 10, 1988, the State Department issued a **Ksylist of Protected** AnimaLsof all those wildlife species requiring governmental protection. Both the Wildlife Protection law and the key List of Protected Anireals have served as linchpins of official Chinese pelicy on domestic wildlife COII. aervation issues ever since.
