插图：China's borders are 22,800 kilometers long and shared with North Korea in the east and Mongolia in the north. It borders with Russia in the northeast and Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan in the northwest. The border is shared with Afghanistan, Pakistan, India, Nepal, and Bhutan in the west and southwest, and is contiguous with Myanmar, Laos and Vietnam in the south. The seas separate China from South Korea, Japan, the Philippines, Brunei, Malaysia, and Indonesia in the east and southeast. China's territorial seas cover an area of 4,730,000 square kilometers and its continental coastline is 18,000 km long. The eastern and southern part of the Chinese mainland is surrounded by the Bohai Sea, the Yellow Sea, the East China Sea and the South China Sea. The Bohai Sea is an inland sea of China, while the Yellow Sea, the East China Sea and the South China Sea are marginal seas of the Pacific Ocean. China is a mountainous country with about two thirds of the total area of the whole country occupied by mountainous regions (mountainous areas, hills and plateau), while the basins and plains only account for one third of the total area. The overall layout of China's terrain is characterized by a higher western section and lower eastern section, which roughly resembles a staircase pattern. The highest stair is the Qinghai-Tibet Plateau, with an average elevation of above 4,000 m, which is famously known as the "Roof of the world". The second stair stretches from the Qinghai-Tibet Plateau to the north and east, consisting of the Inner Mongolia Plateau, the Loess Plateau, the Yun-gui Plateau and the Tarim Basin, the Junggar Basin and the Sichuan Basin, with an average elevation of 1,000 to 2,000 meters.
