Asked about the state of the economy, Obama said "I think we should anticipate that 2009 is going to be a tough year. " "And if we make some good choices, I'm confident that we can limit some of the damage in 2009 and that in 2010 we can start seeing an upward trajectory on the economy." But this is a difficult hole that we've dug ourselves into. " On his foreign policy priorities, Obama said "there's no doubt that managing the transition in Iraq is going to be a top priority. Managing a more effective strategy in Afghanistan will be a top priority. " Recognizing that it is not simply an Afghanistan problem but it's an Afghanistan-Pakistan-India-Kashmir-Iran problem is going to be a priority. "Sorting through our policy with respect to Iran effectively—that will be a priority," he said. Obama told Time that "dealing with our transatlantic alliance in a more constructive way and trying to build a more effective relationship with the newly assertive and, I believe, inappropriately aggressive Russia, when it comes to the invasion of Georgia—that is going to be a priority.
