This volume is a compilation of papers presented at the international conference on Malaysia and Sino-Malaysian Relations held on April 6 and 7, 2005. The conference was held to celebrate the establishment of Institute of Malaysian Studies at Xiamen University, China, and to provide a better understanding of Malaysia and explore the impacts and implications of China's rapid development for Malaysia and Southeast Asia as a whole. The conference brought together more than thirty reputable experts and scholars from Mainland China, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, Australia, Japan, the Netherlands, U. K. , U. S. , China's Hong Kong and China's Taiwan. The book consists of 14 papers, which touch upon a vast array of topics pertinent to Malaysia and Sino-Malaysian relations. They can be divided into two parts. The first half consists of 7 papers dealing with issues on economy, politics, history and culture of Malaysia. The second half presents 7 papers discussing issues on Sino-Malaysian relations and regional cooperation. The wide disciplinary backgrounds of the contributors to this book have enabled broader economic, historical, political and international relations aspects of Malaysia and Sino-Malaysian relations to be discussed. While agreeing to these reform goals , this paper suggests some more detailed and comprehensive institutional reforms for developing countries . First , the central banks , the securities exchange commissions , and other supervision agencies should be made politically independent from the Ministry of Finance and have more legal status of supervision power . Second , state—business relationships should be reorganized . A healthier , more balanced relationship between government , banks and large private-sector actors should be established . This requires a system in which the private sector enjoys strong guarantees of property rights , business freedom , and is capable of airing its views and influencing the political and policy process . But the system must also be one in which the exercise of private economic power is checked by countervailing interests , where there is great transparency both in government business relationships and in corporate governance , and the risks and negative impacts associated with interest exchanges between politicians and business are subject to regulations and legal punishment . This outcome can be achieved in part by the strategic use of the market forces , but it also largely involves a variety of institutional innovation and ultimately political capacities .
